That is the beginning of the hymn written by Robert Lowrey on or about 1874. The verse is slow, tedious and seemingly without hope. There was indeed sadness, grief, a sense of loss and a feeling of total defeat for the movement, the disciples and His mother.

**Matthew 28:59-61**

And when Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, and laid it in his own new tomb, which he had hewn out in the rock: and he rolled a great stone to the door of the sepulcher and departed. There was Mary Magdalene, and the other Mary, sitting over against the sepulcher.

**Matthew 29:1-6**

In the end of the sabbath, as it began to dawn toward the first day of the week, came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulcher; and, behold, there was a great earthquake: for the angel of the Lord descended from heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door, and sat upon it. His countenance was like lightning, and his raiment white as snow: And for fear of him the keepers did shake and became as dead men. And the angel answered and said unto the women, "Fear not ye: for I know that ye seek Jesus, which was crucified. He is not here: for he is risen, as he said." Come, see the place where the Lord lay.

But Jesus' death was not the end, it was the beginning, the beginning of a new covenant, a new path to forgiveness, a new path to life, a new path to eternity. On Sunday, the first day of the week, three days after the crucifixion, sadness turned to joy, grief turned to jubilation, loss and defeat turned to victory! And it is reflected in the upbeat chorus!

And He lives forever with His saints to reign  
He arose! He arose!  
Hallelujah! Christ arose!**
